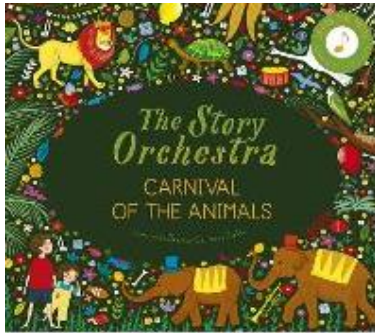

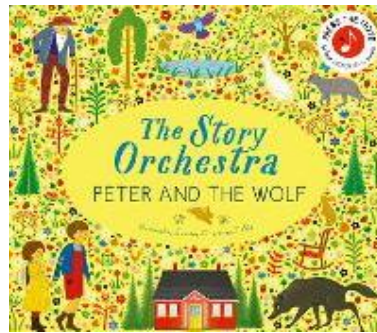
### Story orchestra

Carnival of the Animals (yr 3)



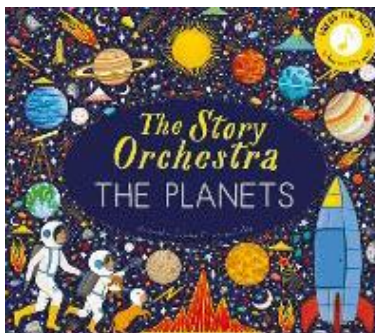
Peter and the Wolf (yr 3)



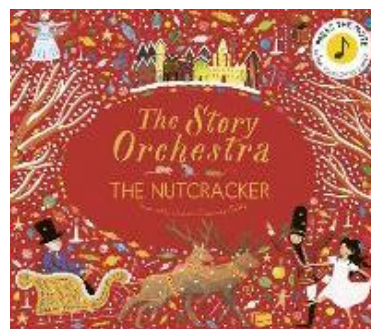
The Four seasons (yr4)

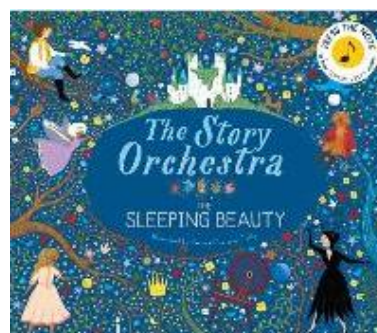

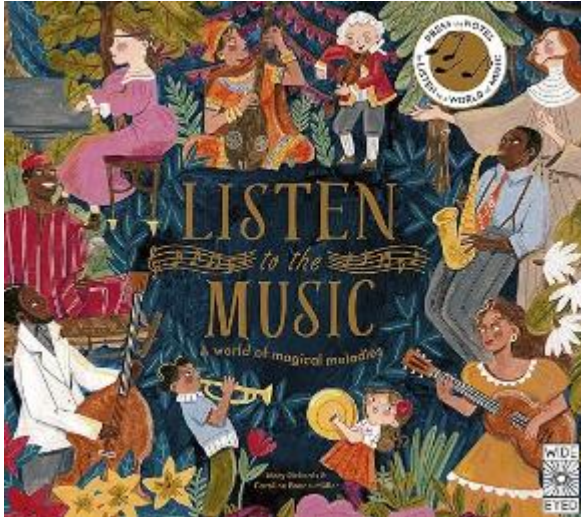
