Computing Curriculum	Every computing lesson includes an Online Safety activity focusing on a scenario and the Four C's.
PSHE Curriculum	We have liaised with the PSHE subject lead and integrated online safety into relevant PSHE lessons.
Assemblies	There will be one year group assembly per half term that focuses on an area of Online Safety.
Parent Communication	Every week, there will be a tweet on the school Twitter account with useful information on how parents can support children in the online world. There will be an element of reactivity to current topics or issues where information will be shared. There will links on the website to direct parents to useful sites for further support. Parents will be invited to attend an annual Online Safety Talk with a guest speaker.
Whole School	As a minimum we will have a whole school online safety day during the nationwide 'Safer Internet Day'.
Display	In the Computing Suite, there will be an online safety display with key reminders for children that will used regularly in lessons.
