

Medication in School

Where possible please give medication at home. If medication needs to be taken during the school day only prescription medication is accepted. We do not accept non-prescribed medication such as Calpol, Piraton, herbal medication, creams, lozenges etc.

Please complete an Administration of Medicine form, which can be found on our website (under Our Families > Forms,) and bring into reception along with the medication in its full and original packaging with the prescription label attached.

Medication must be handed into school by the parent. Medication (inhalers and auto injector pens) will be kept in the classroom, other medication will be kept in the medical room.

If your child requires an allergy auto-injector pen it is recommended that two of these are kept in school.

On the last day of the school year medication will be returned to your child to bring home.

Children are NOT permitted to carry any medication on their person or in their bag.
