## Year 4 Savoury Muffin making

Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term in D.T, Year 4 will be making savoury muffins. Each class will be making their muffins on the same day, as well as designing a muffin box for their product.

Muffin making day: Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> December

In order for the children to make their own muffins, they will need to bring in:

- a mixing bowl
- a wooden spoon
- a tea towel
- muffin cases x4
- A container (to transport the muffins home in)
- A muffin tin
- chosen fillings and any toppings

Please bring the above equipment and ingredients in, **on the 4<sup>th</sup> December** (and not before) in a **named** carrier bag. The school will provide the ingredients for the muffin base mixture, but you will need to provide the fillings and/or toppings your child chooses as part of their design (a small portion of these please, only enough for 4 muffins, as we do not have the facilities to refrigerate/ store any ingredients not used). If your child wishes to bring in meat as an extra ingredient for their muffins, please make sure this has been cooked before it is brought to school as we do not have the time or the capacity to cook it in school.

If you have a muffin tin that you are happy to have your child bring in to school, we would greatly appreciate this. We will have spares to ensure everyone has one but we cannot provide enough for one each.

A paper slip should have come home in your child's bag already with the ingredients and/or toppings your child has decided to use. For those children who have allergies, we will provide alternative base ingredients for the children.

A few things to note: Please ensure that your child comes to school in the morning with the equipment and ingredients that they need for their muffins as things should not be brought in throughout the school day.

At the end of the school day, the children will be able to take **3** of their 4 cooked muffins home with them, to enjoy and share (as they will be eating one in school to evaluate it). The children will still be having their normal lunch; the muffins will not be replacing this.
