## FINAL REMINDER: Year 4 and 5 Bikeability 2026

We are pleased to be able to offer you a Bikeability Level 1 training course provided by Surrey County Council. Training will take place in April and May 2026.

The cost of the course is £10 per child and is payable through the Bikeability enrolment website. When you finish enrolling, you will receive a confirmation email from Surrey County Council cycle training team. Please note that enrolment closes on **20<sup>th</sup> February 2026**.

Your child will be allocated to one of the courses by the cycle team, after which you will receive a further email giving your dates and times. Parents will not be able to select a specific date. On your child's allocated date, your child will need to bring to school their bike and helmet. Bikes are to be left in the bike shed. The course is typically 3 hours delivered in a single day for year 4 and 5 children.

Children will need to have a roadworthy bike, that is in a safe condition and has brakes. The Bikeability team will not be able to make repairs. The children need to be able to ride a bike. This course is for riders learn to control and master their cycles in a space away from traffic, such as a playground. This course is not a learn to ride course.

The instructors are authorised to make minor adjustments, with your child's consent, such as adjusting saddle height, but they are not cycle mechanics. It is also compulsory that each child has a good fitting cycle helmet.

As this event is managed by Surrey County Council the school will not be able to send reminders to those children who are not enrolled.

The specific date that your child will be having their training will be sent to you in due course, along with further details.
