PGL Little Canada - Final Reminders

Dear Parents/Carers,

PGL is almost here! Please read the final information below (also shared at the information evening).

Medication

Medication will be collected **Thursday 23rd April at 8:30am** outside the school office. This includes inhalers, morning/evening medication and travel sickness tablets. Any medication that is held in school will be taken with us.

- Medication must be **clearly labelled**, in **original packaging**, and accompanied by a completed **administration form** (attached).
- Please place medication and form together in a plastic bag.
- If medication is already kept in school, a form is still required.
- No medication can be handed in on the morning of travel.
- For travel sickness tablets, some may be given before school, with tablets/forms still provided for the return journey.

Paracetamol, Antihistamine and Travel Sickness Medication while we are away

When we are away, we occasionally have children who may require paracetamol, antihistamine or travel sickness medication, and this is something that we take with us. Most parents have already consented to this on Arbor. If you have not given consent, we will not be able to give your child this medication while we are away. If you need to update this consent, please visit your Arbor Portal or App.

Packed lunch & water bottle

Children need a **disposable packed lunch for Monday** and a **named water bottle**. No snacks unless agreed in advance due to allergies.

Pocket money

Children may bring **up to £5**, in a named wallet/purse, handed in **between 20th – 24th April**. This must not be brought in on the morning of travel.

Updates will be shared on the school website during the trip, this will be in a password protected section of the website. The password to access this page will be shared with parents of the PGL children soon.



Travel arrangements

Children should arrive at school from **7.45am**. We depart at **8:20am**. When the children arrive to school, they will need to come to the school hall from the back entrance where they will need to find their luggage drop off point (their coach number) and then their class teacher to register. We ask that your farewells take place outside of the hall and that the children come into the hall independently. Parents may wait outside of the school gates to wave the children goodbye, if they wish. On the Friday, we will return for a normal school pick up time and we will communicate any updates to you.

PGL Packing List

Please use the following checklist to help pack bags (please put your child's name on all items of clothing):

Item	Additional Information
Packed lunch for Monday	In a bag that can be thrown away
Water bottle	To be used throughout the week with their name on.
Outfit for Monday	This will need to be suitable for their 1 st activity, should they not have enough time to change beforehand.
Leavers' hoodie	Children must come to school on the Monday wearing this. Please wash in advance otherwise your child's clothes may end up covered in bobbles of purple fluff!
Additional hoodies and thick jumpers	
Long sleeved tops	Many of the activities require these to be worn for safety reasons.
Full length trousers/leggings/tracksuit bottoms	Many of the activities require these to be worn for safety reasons.
Additional tops and bottoms as necessary	
Outdoor trainers or sturdy footwear	That can get very muddy.
Indoor trainers or footwear	To wear into the canteen and to other indoor activities.
One disco outfit	
One towel	
Toiletries bag containing toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc	Deodorant must be roll-on as aerosols set off the fire alarms.
Pyjamas	
Socks and underwear	
Waterproof jacket or coat	
Two plastic bags	One for dirty clothes and one for dirty trainers.
Sun hat and sun lotion	Fingers crossed we'll need them!
Camera – optional	This must only function as a camera e.g. no game or communication facilities.
£5 in a named wallet	To be brought to school between 22nd and 25th April and given to class teacher.

Torch (optional)	

Do not bring mobile phones, expensive cameras, electronic games, expensive/favourite clothing or shoes.
