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Dear Resident/ Occupier,

Subject: Old Bisley Road, Frimley – Proposed Raised Traffic Light Pedestrian Crossing

We previously carried out public engagement to seek feedback from residents and other key stakeholders on a scheme proposing the introduction of the following measures:

- 20mph speed limit in roads in the area around the Ravenscote, Tomlinscote, and St Augustine's schools.
- Supporting traffic calming measures in Old Bisley Road and Upper Chobham Road (a combination of speed tables and speed cushions).
- A traffic light pedestrian crossing on a raised table in Old Bisley Road and associated improvements to the pavement and nearby bus stop.

441 responses were received to the engagement. The table below summarises the views expressed on the various proposed measures:

How do you feel about the proposed lower speed limits?	33.0%	10.3%	56.7%

Following a thorough review of the responses, and in consultation with local county councillors, it was agreed to proceed with the installation of the raised, traffic light pedestrian crossing on Old Bisley Road (including associated improvements to the pavement and nearby bus stop). However, it was decided not to move forward with the proposed 20mph speed limit or traffic calming measures.

Following completion of the detailed design of the crossing and the associated measures, we are writing to inform you that we are now carrying out the legal advertisement of the proposals.

- b) by using the online form via the website quoted above – **by 30 September 2026.**

All comments received will be considered before deciding how to proceed.
